That the Board of Supervisors approve advanced step appointment for IT Systems Supervisor Ulf Engert (Class 0645, Salary Range 460) in Budget Unit 3550-118 to Salary Step "D" effective November 19, 2017.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

The Department believes that the advanced step is warranted based on Mr. Engert's demonstrated abilities as IT Systems Supervisor and based on Mr. Engert's qualifications and experience.

Mr. Engert has been instrumental in developing new processes and procedures associated with advancing Information Technology platforms to an advanced level of deployment. A primary example of this is the migration from an on premise Microsoft Exchange environment to a cloud based Microsoft Exchange

environment with advanced threat protection, encryption, and the ability to access Outlook from anywhere with a desktop browser or mobile interface. Mr. Engert has also been primarily responsible for several upgrades to internal infrastructure, which contributed to the uptime of several public safety departments, including installation of the new wireless communications in the courthouse and firmware upgrades to back office servers. He also had the primary responsibility for deployment of the new CENIC (Corporation for Education Network Initiatives in California) network, the KACE (Endpoint Systems Management Appliance) deployment, the Granicus Media server replacement, the new Willow Creek Sheriff Substation IT equipment, the Elections server replacement, new remote support tools and the migration to the new Storage Area Network (SAN).

There have also been numerous successful networking tasks behind the scenes (including the computer room redesign and the de-install/re-install of all servers and large capacity uninterruptable power supplies) that have allowed the IT infrastructure to remain stable and ensure the integrity of user data. Mr. Engert began his employment with IT on September 27, 2015 and since that time he has demonstrated that he can take on challenging IT projects and see them to completion. Mr. Engert has also remained dedicated in a time of high turnover and low IT resources.

Mr. Engert is uniquely qualified to help reshape the technical infrastructure to adapt to today's modern environment.

#### **FINANCIAL IMPACT:**

The salary difference between the IT Systems Supervisor at Salary Step "B" and Salary Step "D" is \$601.22 per month. This equates to approximately \$7,214 annually. Costs for the advanced Salary Step "D" will be covered by salary savings from several open positions in IT and charged to the IT Fund Budget Unit 3500-118.

This request supports the Board's strategic framework by providing a leadership structure that supports an environment that provides for and maintains infrastructure, improves health and safety, and promotes vibrant communities.
