DISCUSSION:

Public Works received a grant to develop engineering plans and acquire permits for replacing the boat ramp and boarding docks at the Jimmy Smith Fields Landing Boat Launching Facility. Funds were not incorporated into the FY 2017-18 budget because grant-funded work was expected to be completed in FY 2016-17. However, additional work remains including acquiring a coastal development permit, submitting the plans for review by a certified access specialist and completing the construction bid documents. This supplemental budget incorporates the anticipated costs into the FY 2017-18 budget.
