DISCUSSION:

The Office of the District Attorney (DA) has received notification of grant funding through the State of California – Department of Insurance, for the period July 1st 2017 through June 30th 2018, to continue the Workers' Compensation Insurance Fraud Program in the amount of \$201,654.

This is the eighth year the District Attorney has participated in this program. The funds will be used locally to fund 1.0 full time equivalent (FTE) District Attorney Investigator, and .50 FTE Deputy District Attorney starting July 1, 2017. Both the Del Norte and Trinity County District Attorney's Offices have entered into an agreement with the Humboldt County District Attorney to develop a regional Insurance Fraud Unit. The resources here will be available to investigate and prosecute Workers' Compensation fraud cases in those counties.

The Insurance Fraud Unit will be involved in community outreach to inform local contractors and insurance companies who handle worker's compensation claims and insurance policies in how to identify workers' compensation insurance fraud and how to report the suspected insurance fraud. This outreach will aid in improving services to the business communities in all three regional areas.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Acceptance of the one year grant award will allow the District Attorney to be reimbursed up to a maximum of \$201,654 for services performed in accordance with the scope of work described in the grant for the period of July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018. The anticipated grant award originally in the amount of \$200,000 for the FY 2017-18 was accepted and increased to \$201,654 by the State of California. In acceptance of the grant award there is a supplemental amount of \$1,654. This will be used to supplement expert witness fees as well as enhance staff development and training. The program will fund 1.50 FTE employees.

Approval of this agenda item supports the Board's strategic framework by creating opportunities for improved public safety and providing community appropriate levels of service by seeking outside funding sources to benefit Humboldt County needs while building inter-jurisdictional and regional cooperation.

ALTERNATIVES TO STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

The Board may decide not to accept the grant award from the State of California, however, this is not recommended. Non-acceptance of the grant award will cause a loss of revenue for the Humboldt County District Attorney's Office and would leave the community, as well as, the region without a Workers' Compensation Insurance Fraud Investigative Unit.


