<u>DISCUSSION</u>: The Humboldt County Board of Supervisors is the governing and appointing body for the First Five Humboldt Commission. As such, the Board has received a request from Commissioner Lorey Keele to be reappointed to the First Five Humboldt Commission for a second term. Commissioner Keele has been serving on the Commission since her appointment on March 28, 2017 which allowed her to fill the term of Cameron Mull which expired on January 7, 2018.




