DISCUSSION:

On September 26, 2017, the Humboldt County Department of Health and Human Services ("DHHS") submitted a Technical Assistance Grant Application to the California Department of Housing and Community Development ("HCD") for Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000.00) in one-time funding under the No Place Like Home ("NPLH") Program. If received, DHHS would use such funding to support eligible activities that further the planning, design and implementation of permanent supportive housing and accompanying supportive services for individuals suffering from serious mental illness.

The county's NPLH Technical Assistance Grant Application was submitted to HCD with the County Administrative Officer's approval in accordance with the county's grant application procedures. However, HCD has subsequently requested that the county adopt a resolution authorizing the DHHS Director, or a designee thereof, to execute and deliver a State of California Standard Agreement, and any future amendments thereto, along with any and all other documents required or deemed necessary or appropriate to accept the NPLH Technical Assistance Grant funds on behalf of the County.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Upon approval of the county's NLPH Technical Assistance Grant Application, DHHS – Mental Health will receive one-time technical assistance funding in the amount of Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000.00), to be deposited in DHHS – Mental Health Administration budget unit 1170-424. There is no match requirement for NPLH Technical Assistance Grant in question. As a result, adoption of the attached resolution will not impact the Humboldt County General Fund.

The recommended action supports the Board of Supervisors' Strategic Framework by protecting vulnerable populations, supporting self-reliance of citizens and improving the safety and health of our communities.

ALTERNATIVES TO STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

WHEREAS, the California Department of Housing and Community Development ("HCD") is authorized to provide up to Six Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$6,200,000.00) from the Mental Health Services Act Fund for technical assistance and application preparation assistance to counties, as described in California Welfare and Institutions Code Section 5849.10, related to the No Place Like Home ("NPLH") Program; and

WHEREAS, on April 10, 2017, HCD issued a Notice of Funding Availability ("NFOA") for its NPLH Technical Assistance Grants; and

WHEREAS, on September 26, 2017, the County of Humboldt ("County") submitted a NPLH Technical Assistance Grant Application in accordance with the NPLH Technical Assistance Grant NOFA dated April 10, 2017 and the NPLH Program Technical Assistance Grant Guidelines released by HCD.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE HUMBOLDT COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. The County's submission of the NPLH Technical Assistance Grant Application dated September 26, 2017 for funding in the amount of Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000.00) is hereby ratified.

2. If-the County's NPLH Technical Assistance Grant Application dated September 26, 2017 is approved by HCD, the Humboldt County Department of Health and Human Services Director, or a designee thereof, is hereby authorized to enter into, execute and deliver a State of California Standard Agreement ("State Standard Agreement") for the amount of Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000.00), and any future amendments thereto, along with any and all other documents required or deemed necessary or appropriate to evidence and secure the NPLH Technical Assistance Grant and the County's obligations related thereto.

3. The County shall be subject to the terms and conditions specified in the State Standard Agreement, California Welfare and Institutions Code Sections 5849.1, et seq.), and any applicable NPLH Technical Assistance Grant Guidelines published by HCD. NPLH Technical Assistance Grant funds are to be used for allowable project expenditures as specifically identified in the State Standard Agreement. The County's NPLH Technical Assistance Grant Application dated September 26, 2017 will be incorporated into the State Standard Agreement as though fully set forth therein. Any and all activities funded, information provided and timelines represented in the County's NPLH Technical Assistance Grant Application dated September 26, 2017 will be enforceable through the executed State Standard Agreement. The County hereby agrees to use all NPLH Technical Assistance Grant funds received thereby for eligible uses in the manner presented in the County's NPLH Technical

The Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) is pleased to announce the availability of approximately \$6.2 million in funding for Technical Assistance (TA) Grants for the No Place Like Home (NPLH) Program. The NPLH Program provides loans and grants to counties investing in permanent supportive housing for persons who are in need of mental health services and are experiencing homelessness, chronic homelessness, or are at risk-of chronic homelessness within their jurisdiction. The amount of the TA Grant awards will vary by county, based on population. Counties must apply for funds by the application deadline of September 30, 2017, to qualify for a grant.

A complete original application must be submitted no later than **5:00 p.m. Pacific Standard Time on September 30, 2017**, delivered by private courier or U.S. Mail.

2017 NOTICE OF FUNDING AVAILABILITY (NOFA) NO PLACE LIKE HOME PROGRAM TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE GRANTS

INTRODUCTION

On July 1, 2016, Governor Brown signed legislation¹ enacting the No Place Like Home (NPLH) Program to dedicate \$2 billion in bond proceeds for the development of permanent supportive housing for persons who are in need of mental health services and are experiencing homelessness, chronic homelessness, or are at-risk of chronic homelessness. Welfare and Institutions Code Section 5849.10 appropriates \$6.2 million from the Mental Health Services Fund to provide technical assistance to counties related to the NPLH Program.

FUNDING AVAILABLE

The Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) is announcing the availability of approximately \$6.2 million in funding for Application Preparation and Technical Assistance Grants (TA Grants) for the NPLH Program. Funding is made available from the Mental Health Services Fund pursuant to an appropriation provided by subsection (a) of Section 5849.10 of the Welfare and Institutions Code.

PROGRAM SUMMARY

NPLH Program TA Grants will be awarded to counties² to fund eligible activities that support the planning, design and implementation of Coordinated Entry Systems, permanent supportive housing and the accompanying supportive services for individuals suffering from serious mental illness. Additional information on eligible activities and other requirements is contained in the NPLH Program Technical Assistance Guidelines that are available on the HCD webpage at http://www.hcd.ca.gov/grants-funding/active-funding/nplh.shtml.

TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE GRANT AMOUNTS

Upon submission of an application (on the HCD form provided) and approval by HCD, HCD shall award funds in the form of a grant as follows:

- \$150,000 to the County of Los Angeles and to large counties (population greater than 750,000);
- \$100,000 to medium counties (population between 200,000 to 750,000); and
- \$75,000 to small counties (population less than 200,000).

APPLICATION SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Applications will be accepted beginning the first business day following release of this NOFA and must be received by HCD no later than **5:00 p.m.** on **September 30, 2017**. HCD will only accept applications through a postal carrier service such as U.S. Postal Service, UPS, Fed Ex or other carrier services that provide date stamp verification confirming delivery to HCD's office. Please contact HCD if delivery is not completed by fault of the private courier/U.S. Mail. **Personal deliveries are not accepted.** The delivery address is:

Applications that do not meet the filing deadline will not be eligible for funding. Applications must be on the HCD form provided and cannot be altered or modified by the Applicant.

THRESHOLD REQUIREMENTS

All applications must meet the following threshold requirements:

- Completed and signed original application.
- Resolution from the governing body of the jurisdiction (typically the County Board of Supervisors), with specific permission to apply for and receive NPLH Program Technical Assistance Grant funds. For a sample Resolution, see Attachment A.

APPLICANT NOTIFICATION

Applicants will be notified within 30 days of HCD's receipt of their application regarding the status of the application and any additional information required.

AWARD LETTER AND STANDARD AGREEMENT

Successful applicants will receive an Award Letter from HCD and will be awarded funds through the Standard Agreement process that will specify, among other things, the amount of funds granted, timeline for expenditure of funds, and the approved use of funds. Expenditure report dates and other requirements will also be identified in the NPLH Program TA Grant Award Standard Agreement.
