That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Receive and file the bids for Williams Creek Bridge Replacement on Grizzly Bluff Road.
2. Award the contract to McCullough Construction, Inc., for the total amount of \$1,854,575.20.
3. Authorize the Chair of the Board to execute the project agreement upon submittal of the appropriate bonds and insurance.
4. Direct the Auditor-Controller to establish a new contract account 1200321-0330 and transfer \$2,319,819 from 1200321-2118 to the new contract account per the attached appropriation transfer.

DISCUSSION:

On January 9, 2018, the Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise the above-referenced project for bids. On February 13, 2018, the county received five (5) bids for the project. The results are as follows:

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

This project is being funded through the Federal Highway Administration Highway Bridge Program, which will provide eighty-eight point fifty-three (88.53) percent of funding. The county road fund will cover the remaining eleven point forty-seven (11.47) percent of the project costs. Construction costs were included in the Fiscal Year 2017-18 Road Fund Budget; therefore, this item has no impact on the General Fund.

This project conforms to the Board of Supervisors' Core Role of providing for and maintaining infrastructure as identified in the Board's Strategic Framework.
