Subject: Remove Frozen Indefinitely (FØ) – Designation for Roads Assistant Engineer I/II Position (4/5 vote required)

RECOMMENDATION(S): That the Board of Supervisors

Remove the Frozen Indefinitely (FØ) designation from 1.0 FTE Assistant Engineer I/II (class 306) position in budget unit 321, effective at the beginning of the next biweekly pay period following approval. (4/5 vote required)

SOURCE OF FUNDING: Roads Engineering 1200-321

DISCUSSION:

The recent resignation of the Senior Engineering Technician has created a staff shortage in the Public Works Engineering Division. The division does not intend to fill the Senior Engineering Technician position during the current fiscal year which will result in salary savings for the unit.

The Public Works Engineering Division would like to request that the Assistant Engineering I/II position be unfrozen, funded and filled. The number of staff in the division will remain the same, but an Assistant Engineer position provides more flexibility and this position will be critical for the large workload from the winter of 2017, the upcoming storm season and will provide much needed support for the division.
