SOURCE OF FUNDING:

Public Health Funds

DISCUSSION:

Sections 120325-120380 of the Health and Safety Code require immunizations against childhood diseases prior to school admittance. Local Health Officers are required to organize and maintain a program to make available the immunizations required for admittance to child-care facilities and schools. The DHHS – Public Health Immunization Program meets these requirements by providing an immunization clinic and coordinating with local providers to ensure vaccine availability.

The goal of the DHHS - Public Health Immunization Program is to assess and improve immunization levels among infants, preschool aged children, kindergarten entrants and incoming transfer students; to provide provider and community education, prevention, surveillance and outbreak control; to reduce, and if possible eliminate illness, disability and death due to vaccine preventable diseases within Humboldt County.

The State Standard Agreement #17-10318 before your Board today funds the DHHS – Public Health Immunization Program from July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2022 for a total of \$455,160.

This agreement is coming to your Board after the start date due to late receipt from the state.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Approval of the agreement with CDPH will allow Public Health to be reimbursed for up to \$91,032 per year for fiscal years (FY) 2017-18 through 2021-22 in Fund 1175, Budget Unit 428, Immunization Program for the period of July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2022, for a total of \$455,160. These funds were anticipated and included in the approved 2017-18 FY county budget and the remaining funding amount of \$91,032 per year will be included in the county budget process for FYs 2018-19, 2019-20, 2020-21 and 2021-22. There will be no impact to the county's General Fund.

This agreement supports the Board's Strategic Framework by protecting vulnerable populations and providing community-appropriate levels of service.

GRANT AGREEMENT NUMBER 17–10318

The Department awards this Grant and the Grantee accepts and agrees to use the Grant funds as follows:

AUTHORITY: The Department has authority to grant funds for the Project under Health and Safety Code, Section 120325-120380 of the Health & Safety Code, which requires immunizations against childhood diseases prior to school admittance and Federal Grant number 5NH23IP000717-05-00.

PURPOSE: The Department shall provide a grant to and for the benefit of the Grantee; the purpose of the Grant is to assist LHDs in preventing and controlling VPDs in the LHJ. The Grantee is to implement activities to:

- Assess and improve coverage levels in the jurisdiction of all vaccines recommended by the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) to protect the population.
- Detect, report, and control vaccine-preventable diseases in the jurisdiction.

Related Statutes

California Health & Safety Code sections:

- 120130 requires the Local Health Officers to properly report to CDPH those diseases listed as reportable, which include vaccine-preventable diseases.
- 120175 requires the Local Health Officers to take measures as may be necessary to prevent the spread or occurrence of additional cases of reportable diseases (which includes reportable vaccine-preventable diseases).
- 120350 requires Local Health Officers to organize and maintain a program to make available the immunizations required for admittance to child care facilities and schools.

GRANT AMOUNT: The maximum amount payable under this Grant shall not exceed Four

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Hundred Fifty-Five Thousand One Hundred Sixty dollars (\$455,160).

TERM OF GRANT: The term of the Grant shall begin on July 1, 2017, and terminates on June 30, 2022. No funds may be requested or invoiced for work performed or costs incurred after June 30, 2022.
