WIOA requires certain public agencies and labor unions to be appointed members of the HC-WDB. HC-WDB membership must be balanced with an equal number, plus one, of private sector members, as WIOA regulations require that at least 51 percent of the HC-WDB membership is composed of the private sector.

The HC-WDB Executive Committee received and reviewed an application to fill a current vacancy and recommended appointment of the applicant at their April 26, 2018 meeting. The proposed appointment is in accordance with the HC-WDB bylaws. John Woolley represents the Northern California Indian Development Council (NCIDC) and has been nominated by NCIDC's Director, Greg Gehr, to fill a vacant community-based organization seat.
