PUBLIC NOTICE

These amendments modify Section 335-5 of Humboldt County Code -the Flood Damage Prevention Ordi-nance - to Allow Temporary Struc-tures in Mapped Flood Hazard Areas. More specifically, the amend-ments allow the Chief Building Offi-cial to issue permits for a 180 day time period for temporary struc-tures in flood hazard areas when those structures do not meet all the anchoring, flood resistance and flood proofing requirements for per-manent structures.
