# AMENDMENT NO. 1 COMPENSATION AGREEMENT (Future Development Properties)

This First Amendment to the Compensation Agreement, dated for reference purposes as of October \_\_\_, 2018, (this "Amendment") is entered into by and among the Successor Agency to the City of Eureka Redevelopment Agency, the City of Eureka, the County of Humboldt, the Humboldt County Library, Humboldt Bay Municipal Water District, Humboldt Bay Harbor Recreation and Conservation District, Humboldt County Office of Education, Eureka City Unified School District and College of the Redwoods Community College District, on the basis of the following facts, understandings, and intentions of the Parties.

WHEREAS, the Compensation Agreement was circulated to the Parties on July 18, 2018; and

WHEREAS, subsequent guidance from the California Department of Finance revealed an inapplicable reference to the Health and Safety Code in the Compensation Agreement, necessitating this Amendment; and

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing recitals which are hereby incorporated into this Amendment by this reference, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which consideration is hereby acknowledged, the Parties hereby agree that the Compensation Agreement is amended to read as follows:

## 1. RECITAL E:

E. The Successor Agency prepared and obtained Oversight Board approval of the Successor Agency's LRPMP on June 8, 2015, calling for the Former Agency's properties to be liquidated, transferred to the City for governmental use, or retained by the City for future disposition by the City and development by selected Developers to implement projects identified in the Redevelopment Plan pursuant to a compensation agreement to be entered into among the City and the Taxing Entities.

#### 2. Section 2(a)(2):

(2) Approval of this Agreement by the Successor Agency's governing board and direction for the Successor Agency to execute this Agreement; and

#### 3. Section 7(b):

(b) <u>Early Termination</u>. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Agreement or the LRPMP, a Party may terminate this Agreement upon written notice to the other Parties if a court order, legislation, or DOF policy reverses the DOF's directives regarding the need for this Agreement (an "Early Termination"). Subject to the satisfaction of such condition, an Early Termination shall become effective five (5) days after the terminating Party delivers the required notice to the other Parties in accordance with Section 8(a). Upon effectiveness of an Early Termination, no Party shall have any further rights or obligations under this Agreement, and the City may retain all proceeds from the sale of the Property.

### 4. Terms and Conditions

Except as otherwise modified in this Amendment, the terms and conditions of the Compensation Agreement and the rights, duties, and obligations of the parties thereunder are unchanged and remain in full force and effect.
