Statement of Interest in serving:

I am a 27-year resident of McKinleyville and I care about the future of our beautiful county. My husband and I have raised three children here who are now grown but still think of Humboldt County their home. We consider ourselves fortunate to live in one of the most beautiful places on earth and I hope that we can work together to preserve our amazing natural setting while also making Humboldt County a place where families can work and thrive.

As well as raising a family here, I am a California Licensed Architect who has been working in our community since July 1992. I earned my degree in architecture from the University of Michigan College of Architecture and Urban Planning where my focus was on community design. My work here in Northern California has been primarily residential, spread throughout the County's various communities from Big Lagoon to Carlotta and from Manila to Willow Creek. I have been able to apply principles of community design to a few commercial and public building projects over the past 25 years. For example, from 2009 – 2014 I worked with the McKinleyville Community Services District on the computer/conference room addition to the McKinleyville Branch Library, the new Pierson Park Picnic Pavilion, a pump canopy at the Ramey Pump Station on North Bank Road, and preliminary planning leading to the development of the Request for Proposals for the architectural design of the McKinleyville Teen Center. Moreover, since I have coordinated permitting for over 200 projects in Humboldt County, I am familiar with Humboldt County Planning and Building Division's personnel and procedures. A few of the projects I have worked on have come before the Planning Commission, mostly within the Planning Division's recommended consent agenda, but the majority of my projects have not required this.

My work as an architect and agent in the permitting process has given me a good understanding of the challenges that property owners face when seeking to develop and improve their homes, businesses and lands. My work as a mother and homemaker has given me perspective on what is important for making our communities safe, healthy and happy places for families and all residents. I have been a Court Appointed Special Advocate (CASA of Humboldt) since 2012 and my experiences with our county's foster youth has made me aware of the many challenges and unmet needs that must still be addressed within our county.

Thank you for your consideration of my application for the Humboldt County Planning Commission. It would be my honor to serve my community in this capacity.
