Statement of Interest in serving:

I am interested in serving on the McKinleyville Municipal Advisory Committee because I am a 26-year resident of McKinleyville who cares about the future of our community. My husband and I have raised three children here who all attended elementary and middle school in the McKinleyville Union School District and who all graduated from McKinleyville High School. Over this time I have been able to watch and be part of the growth and development of our community and have a good perspective on both the benefits and joys of living here as well as the challenges we face.

As well as raising a family here, I am a California Licensed Architect who has been working in our community since July 1992. I earned my degree in architecture from the University of Michigan College of Architecture and Urban Planning where my focus was on community design. Although my work here in Northern California has been primarily residential, I have been able to apply principles of community design to a few commercial and public building projects over the past 25 years. For example, from 2009 – 2014 I worked with the McKinleyville Community Services District on the computer/conference room addition to the McKinleyville Branch Library, the new Pierson Park Picnic Pavilion, a pump canopy at the Ramey Pump Station on North Bank Road, and preliminary planning leading to the development of the Request for Proposals for the architectural design of the McKinleyville Teen Center. Moreover, since I have coordinated permitting for over 200 projects in Humboldt County, I am also very familiar with Humboldt County Planning and Building Division's personnel and procedures. I would be happy to share my knowledge and experience in this area as it applies to the work of the McKinleyville Municipal Advisory Committee.

Of particular interest to me is working towards developing more of a "town center" for McKinleyville. I would be happy to work with local community members and the McMAC in encouraging and supporting the Humboldt County Planning Division in their development of the Town Center Ordinance.
