*Measure Z,* Humboldt County's Public Safety/Essential Services Measure, was passed by the voters of Humboldt County in the November 2014 general election.

Measure Z will provide funds to maintain and improve public safety and essential services, such as:

- Investigating violent crimes, including rape and domestic violence;
- Maintaining 911 emergency response times;
- Ensuring on-duty Sheriff's deputies;
- Providing drug treatment programs;
- Providing services for the victims of child abuse;
- Repairing roads;
- · Maintaining rural fire protection and ambulance services; and
- Cleaning up environmentally-damaging marijuana farms and illegal dumping.



### **Proposal Narrative**

The D Street Neighborhood Center is one of the City of Arcata's designated emergency disaster shelter as outlined in the Humboldt County's Hazard Mitigation Plan. As an emergency shelter, the center needs to supply shelter and amenities in the case of an emergency event. Additionally, the center need to be able to support community members with various needs. This includes providing food, water, and reliable power. A reliable backup generator at the center will be able to provide power for community members whose medicals needs require electricity.

The City of Arcata is requesting \$30,000.00 to purchase a 25 kW portable backup generator for the D Street Neighborhood Center, with the City willing to match 5% of funds for the remaining cost. The center is critical to the community during an emergency event and needs to provide reliable power to provide safe shelter for those with medical needs requiring refrigeration or electricity. The City is currently considering the 25 kW Doosan Diesel Generation Model G25WDO-3A-T4F with a trailer. The D Street Neighborhood Center's electrical load was recently rated to determine the appropriate size for the generator and is reflected in the model type and size. The city staff will maintain the generators and be on-site during an emergency. Measure Z stickers will be placed on the generator.
