The Humboldt County Citizens' Advisory Committee on *Measure Z* Expenditures is now accepting applications for funding.

Measure Z, Humboldt County's Public Safety/Essential Services Measure, was passed by the voters of Humboldt County in the November 2014 general election.

Measure Z will provide funds to maintain and improve public safety and essential services, such as:

- Investigating violent crimes, including rape and domestic violence;
- · Maintaining 911 emergency response times;
- · Ensuring on-duty Sheriff's deputies;
- Providing drug treatment programs;
- · Providing services for the victims of child abuse;
- · Repairing roads;
- Maintaining rural fire protection and ambulance services; and
- Cleaning up environmentally-damaging marijuana farms and illegal dumping.

Proposal Narrative

The City of Arcata has large spans of local arterial roads that experience high speeds. Many of the roads are in residential areas and residents have made numerous safety complaints. Between 2006 and 2016, there was 163 collisions in Arcata. The largest cause of the collisions were due to unsafe vehicle speeds.

The City of Arcata is requesting \$32,000.00 to purchase five sets of speed radar feedback signs, with the City willing to match 5% of funds for the remaining cost. Speed radar feedback signs are an effective way to notify speeding vehicles and lead to immediate decrease in vehicle speed. The City has purchased and successfully implemented radar feedback signs on two high volume arterial roads in 2018. Since implementation, they have been successfully controlling speed along roads that transition to lower speeds as they enter residential areas.

The City plans to install each set on various arterial roads where high speeds have been numerously reported and near schools that do not have traffic calming features. Locations include 11th Street, Giuntoli Lane, Foster Avenue, Janes Road and Alliance Road. City of Arcata staff is able to install all of the radar speed feedback signs and provide maintenance work on the signs. If funded, Measure Z placards will be displayed on the pole below each radar feedback sign to allow Humboldt county residents to see how their tax dollars are being used.
