Measure Z Narrative:

February 20, 2019

Southern Humboldt Amateur Radio Club, better known as S.H.A.R.C., was founded in 1986, and currently has a membership of over 30 amateur radio operators. Most of its members attended classes offered and taught by its own members, who were then tested and licensed by members and officers of S.H.A.R.C..

The club coordinates communications for local events: The Avenue of Giants Marathons, the Garberville Rodeo Parade, Earthquake - Tsunami Drills, and much more. There's plenty of radio traffic with a weekly 7 pm Monday net to check emergency testing of radios. The club owns and operates three local FM radio repeaters. The 146.790 MHz transmitter above Garberville is linked to the 146.940 MHz repeater above Shelter Cove, and both have local telephone dialing Autopatch access. The 147.33 MHz Grasshopper repeater near Weott completes club coverage of all Southern Humboldt Co. & Northern Mendocino Co. with public service emergency communications, and communications in time of disasters.

The funding requested is to modernize a repeater that was originally a VIP repeater for fire prevention. Now taken over by SHARC. Grasshopper is a (stand alone) repeater. Located west of Weott, Grasshopper covers highway 101 and west, enabling coverage of the Humboldt coast.

The new batteries for our solar powered repeater, will increase operating time during times of less solar charging.

This funding will allow continuity of services and virtually no maintenance needed in this remote location.
