## **POST ADOPTION SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE**

On July 23, 2019, during its regularly scheduled Board meeting, the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance No. \_\_\_\_\_, which repealed the existing Commercial Medical Marijuana Land Use Ordinance (Section 313-55.4 of Chapter 3 of Division 1 of Title III of the County Code and the Medical Cannabis Testing and Research Laboratories and On-site Consumption prohibitions found in Sections 313-55.3.15 and 313-55.3.11.7 of Division 1 of Title III of the County Code to be replaced by the provisions of the proposed ordinance (Section 313-55.4 of Chapter 3 of Division 1 of Title III) with the modifications suggested by the Coastal Commission. The new zones and amendments to the existing zones will become effective thirty (30) days after the date of adoption.
