Humboldt County was named for Alexander Von Humboldt who was a scientific revolutionary whose exploration became building blocks for natural science, ecology and humanitarian justice. Von Humboldt's 250th birthday is September 14, 2019. It will be marked locally by a community collaboration at Eureka's Sequoia Center entitled "Planet Humboldt - A Summit of Inspiration". This event will include activities and discussion ranging from service efforts, governmental planning, and infusing traditional and emerging businesses to education, art and human nature.
