**PUBLIC NOTICE**

On July 23, 2019, during its regularly scheduled Board meeting, the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance No. 2634, which repealed the existing Commercial Medical Marijuana Land Use Ordinance (Section 313-55.4 of Chapter 3 of Division 1 of Title III of the County Code and the Medical Cannabis Testing and Research Laboratories and On-site Consumption prohibitions found in Sections 313-55.3.15 and 313-55.3.11.7 of Division 1 of Title III of the County Code to be replaced by the provisions of the proposed ordinance (Section 313-55.4 of Chapter 3 of Division 1 of Title III) with the modifications suggested by the Coastal Commission. The new zones and amendments to the existing zones will become effective thirty (30) days after the date of adoption.
