WHEREAS, in 1999, the Humboldt County Marshall's Office was absorbed by the Humboldt County Sheriff's Office, and Leslie Borges was once again a Deputy Sheriff, and worked in the Court Protection Unit for fourteen years; and

WHEREAS, in 2010, Leslie Borges transferred to the Operations Division; and

WHEREAS, in 2013 Leslie Borges was promoted to Corporal, and assisted with the training of at least 17 new Patrol Deputies;

WHERAS, in 2018 Leslie Borges returned to working as a Patrol Deputy, where she served with distinction until her retirement this month; and

WHERAS, Leslie Borges has always approached her career in Law Enforcement with passion, enthusiasm, a sense of humor, and most of all compassion for the those she served, and those she served with.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors, Sheriff William F.
