We are an international leader in land-based seafood production. All production takes place indoors in large fish tanks where the water is continuously treated to enable excellent fish welfare.

# The many benefits of our production approach include:

- The only way to meet demand growth is to pursue sustainable farming
- Land-based fish farms protect wild fish stocks

## About our company:

We have operations in Norway, Denmark and the USA. In the US we have projects underway in Belfast, Maine and Humboldt, California. US head-quarters are located in Portland, Maine.



## Key facts about the proposed facility in Humboldt:

- Approx. 30 acres for development at the Samoa Peninsula
- Approx. 400 Mill USD investment to be developed over 2-3 phases.
- 70-80 full-time employees at full build-out
- Significant amount of construction jobs and other local synergies
- Up to 60 Million pounds of fish annual production potential fully expanded
- While pricing varies, the revenue potential is 200 Mill USD annually

Due diligence work is now more or less complete and subject to board review in late September. Water access issues are also being reviewed. Next step in the project would be permitting and engineering to start this fall with deadline for permit application submissions next summer.
