Recommendations for Measure Z Expenditures

The Citizens' Advisory Committee on Measure Z Expenditures has been tasked with assisting the Board of Supervisors in taking public input on the expenditure of funds derived from the county-wide local sales tax imposed pursuant to Measure Z. Forty-seven applications for funding were received from various county departments and outside agencies. Three of those applications were withdrawn by the submitting organizations. Four meetings have been held, to examine the various proposals received and weigh the value of each. The Committee has been asked to make recommendations as to the proposals that should be funded, given the projected amount of revenue expected to be derived from the county-wide local sales tax.

All applications were reviewed and considered. The Committee sorted the applications into "yes" and "no" categories, then prioritized those with a majority "yes" vote into level 1, 2 and 3, with level 1 being of the highest priority. After receiving extensive public input and holding lengthy discussions, the Committee developed a single list, in order of greatest priority, for the Board's consideration. Those applicant funds that will not or cannot be expended during the fiscal year should be reallocated at that time to the Department of Public Works for Roads application.

The following recommendations are submitted to be included as part of the annual budget process to allocate \$3,564,480 available for a combination of one-time and ongoing expenses. The committee understands that adjustments to these recommendations may be required to present a balanced proposed budget:
