WHEREAS, the Six Rivers Running Club is planning the 49<sup>TH</sup> Annual Avenue of the Giants Marathon, Half Marathon, and 10K Race for Sunday, May 3rd, 2020 between the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.; AND

WHEREAS, road closures and controlled traffic are necessary to ensure the safety of runners participating in the marathon.

## NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

On Sunday, May 3, 2020:

- 1. Both lanes of Highway 254 from the southern Redcrest exit from Highway 101 to 6.55 miles south of Dyerville Bridge are closed to all traffic excepting official race and emergency vehicles. People attending church or leaving/returning home will be allowed to pass; and
- 2. Both lanes of the Mattole Road will be controlled by Eureka Volunteer Patrol (EVP) pilot cars from the Dyerville Bridge (Honeydew Founders Tree exit from Highway 101) to a point 6.55 miles west on the Mattole Road.
