RESOLUTION OF THE HUMBOLDT COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS SETTING A SUNSET DATE FOR THE AUTHORIZATION FOR EMERGENCY RESPONSE PAY DURING THE COVID-19 EMERGENCY

- **WHEREAS**, on March 4, 2020, Governor Gavin Newsome proclaimed a State of Emergency to exist in California as a result of the threat of COVID-19; and
- **WHEREAS**, on March 11, the Humboldt County Health Officer declared a local emergency as a result of the threat of COVID-19 which the Board of Supervisors ratified on March 17; and
- **WHEREAS**, On March 16, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution 20-20, implementing new employee procedures and leave accruals in response to COVID-19; and
- **WHEREAS**, on March 19, the County Health Officer and the Governor issued shelter in place orders; and
- **WHEREAS**, On March 24, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution 20-25, implementing further employee procedures and leave accruals in response to COVID-19; and
- **WHEREAS**, On March 30, the Health Officer issued a revised Shelter in Place Order effective until rescinded, based on evidence of increasing occurrence of COVID-19 throughout the County of Humboldt; and
- **WHEREAS** On March 30, 2020, the Director of Emergency Services for the County of Humboldt proclaimed a Local Emergency, which was ratified by the Board of Supervisors on April 6, 2020; and
- **WHEREAS**, On April 14, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution 20-27, implementing further employee procedures and leave accruals in response to COVID-19; and
- **WHEREAS,** the Governor's has signaled that as part of the pandemic road map, the State of California will move in the future from Stage 1 to Stage 2 which allows for creating opportunities for lower risk sectors to adapt and re-open; and
- **WHEREAS**, due to the current local and state emergency, these actions are taken in accord with Government Code Section 3504.5 and the County's adopted employee employer relations policy; and
 - WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors now wishes to establish the sunset date for the

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Emergency Response Pay Premium ("ERPP") enacted as part of Resolution No. 20-27.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

- 1. The Emergency Response Pay Premium authorized under Section 2 of Resolution 20-27, will sunset either: 1) on the date the Governor moves the State of California from Stage 1 to Stage 2 under the pandemic road map and/or 2) when the Governor provides local modification to the State's Stay-at-Home Order, whichever occurs first.
- 2. Except as specifically modified herein, all provisions of Resolution No. 20-27 remain in full force and effect.
- 3. This resolution is to take effect immediately upon passage by the Board of Supervisors.
