50% of the membership **shall** be consumers or the parent, spouse, sibling or adult children of consumers, who are receiving or have received mental health services. At least 20% of the total membership **shall** be consumers, and at least 20% **shall** be families of consumers.

One member of the Board of Supervisors shall be on the board.

No member of the board nor his/her spouse shall be a full-time or part-time county employee of a county mental health service, an employee of the State Department of Mental Health, or an employee of, or a paid member of a governing body of, a Bronzan-McCorguodale contract agency.

TERM:

Three (3) Years (Terms expire 3 years from date of appointment.)

FUNCTION:

*Consumer

Primarily, review and evaluate the community's mental health needs,

services, facilities and special problems; and make an annual report to the

Board of Supervisors.
