To the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors:

I am the President of the Eureka Branch of the NAACP. It has come to my attention that you have been tasked with appointing positions for the Humboldt County Law Library Board of Trustees. The current Board has only one female, Cyndy Day-Wilson and only one black man, Stephan Loreus. All the other members are white men. Both of these individuals are seeking reappointment. Ms. Day-Wilson has years of experience as a Trustee and Mr. Loreus has just served a full term. I am encouraging you to reappoint them both as Trustees of the Humboldt County Law Library Board.

The Trustees should be representatives of the overall community. Removing the only woman and the only black man makes this Board of Trustees less representative of the community. I am sure it can be hard to get people to volunteer to be on these boards so hopefully you will not eliminate two qualified candidates that will keep some diversity on the board.
