Our programs include but are not limited to financial assistance, drug and alcohol recovery support, career advancement tools and other resources with the purpose of improving their lives, as well as their contribution to our community. Over the years our organization has supported thousands of single mothers in domestic abuse situations, drug dependency, homelessness and poverty. Our vision is to see that no single mother in Humboldt County walks alone.

Our organization is seeking to strengthen and expand its programs through a recovery center. Single mothers and their children are among the most vulnerable people in our communities. Drug dependency adds complexity, vulnerability, risks and setbacks to their present and their future. With a recovery center, we would begin to implement one-to-one, group therapy and professional counseling for single mother families struggling with drug and alcohol, domestic violence and other life-threatening situations. A center would allow us to implement ongoing support groups to teach positive parenting, financial wellness, spiritual wellbeing, self-defense and career advancement. Additionally, we would expand our basic needs programs such as a food pantry, clothing closet and the housing of furniture and appliances for newly housed single moms leaving domestic violence situations with no belongings. These and future programs would only be possible upon the opening of our center. For this reason, The Free to Fly Single Mom's Fund Foundation is requesting Measure Z funding.
