Update on Local Conditions Surrounding Drought

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Receive a verbal report from the Humboldt County Drought Task Force regarding the current status and impacts of drought in Humboldt County; and
- 2. Approve moving the Humboldt County Drought Task Force reports to every 6 months.

DISCUSSION:

The Humboldt County Drought Task Force was established on May 25, 2021 by the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors. The task force has been directed to explore and develop potential short, medium, and long-term actions for a coordinated, county-wide response as well as track local impacts resulting from drought.

Since its creation on May 25, 2021, the Drought Task Force has met to discuss local impacts and response strategies, providing regular updates to the Board of Supervisors and the community via formal reports and social and conventional media. Until directed otherwise, the Drought Task Force

plans to provide routine reports to the Board of Supervisors as new information becomes available or as mitigation and/or response actions are identified. Due to the necessity and content of reports, it is recommended that these reports are moved to every six months rather than every other month.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

There is minimal financial impact to receiving this report, and while staff costs for the Local Drought Task Force were not included in the Fiscal Year 2022-2023 budget, participating departments have so far been able to carry out your Board's direction related to the task force without additional funding.
