The Planning Commission approve the proposed VMT thresholds of significance and recommendations to the Board of Supervisors for final action. Adoption of the proposed VMT thresholds of significance are exempt from environmental review as provided in Section 15308 of the California Environmental Quality Act (Local agency actions to assure protection of the environment).
