Title: Inland and coastal zone ordinances to allow the use of residences for short-term rentals within the

unincorporated areas of Humboldt County. The ordinance does the following:

a) Creates two tiers of rentals consisting of units partially rented by the occupants of the

b) Establishes performance criteria for the operation of short term rentals;

c) Creates an Administrative Permit to authorize rentals which comply with the ordinance and

allows approval of a discretionary permit when deviations from standards are requested;
