That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve the donation of one (1) Brush Cutter to Heavy Equipment for capitalizations, maintenance and insurance purposes.

DISCUSSION:

Solid Waste requested the purchase of one (1) Brush Cutter for use at Table Bluff Landfill. Purchase of the equipment was included in the fiscal year (FY) 2020-21 county budget, budget unit 3691-438. For the purposes of capitalization, maintenance and insurance, Solid Waste would like to donate the equipment to Heavy Equipment.
