DISCUSSION:

The Board of Supervisors is sending a letter to the California Department of Fish & Wildlife (CDFW) expressing concerns over the 2023 Nearshore Groundfish Fishery Season Closure. As a rural coastal community, many of our residents are reliant on the local marine fishery for their livelihood, such as charter boat owners, fishing supply stores, and seafood restaurants. Sport ocean fishing and tourism is a major attractant for visitors to our community and many sectors of our economy rely on this tourism.
