Letter of Support for California Senate Bill (SB) 1053 (Blakespear) - Solid Waste: Reusable Grocery Bags: Standards: Plastic Film Prohibition

**DISCUSSION:**

SB 1053 (Blakespear) revises the state's single-use carryout bag ban to eliminate the distribution of thicker film plastic bags and limits the distribution of bags at the point of sale to recycled paper bags. It would prohibit stores from selling reusable grocery bags to consumers unless they meet specified standards. This ban would begin in January 2025.
