The parcel is currently developed with a single-family residence and barn that will remain on the Remainder parcel. Pursuant to Section 325-9, the applicant is requesting an exception to the 50-foot right of way width and proposes a 35-foot right of way. The parcels will be served with community water and sewer provided by the McKinleyville Community Services District.
