Title:	Cut Creek Farms, LLC, Conditional Use Permit Record Number PLN-12570-CUP Assessor's Parcel Numbers: 218-091-009. Garberville area A Conditional Use Permit to allow 15,200 square feet (SF) of cannabis cultivation. Water for irriga is sourced from an onsite 1,000,000-gallon rainwater catchment pond. Water is stored in the pond in three (3) 5,000-gallon hard plastic tanks and one (1) 2,800-gallon hard plastic tank. Total water storage is 1,017,800 gallons. Estimated annual water use is 314,690 gallons, which equates to 21 gallons per SF of cultivation area. Drying and packaging occurs onsite in a 1,280-SF shed. A Conditional Use Permit to allow 15,200 square feet (SF) of cannabis cultivation. Water for irrigation is sourced from an onsite 1,000,000-gallon rainwater catchment pond. Water is stored in the pond and in three (3) 5,000-gallon hard plastic tanks and one (1) 2,800-gallon hard plastic tank. Total water storage is 1,017,800 gallons. Estimated annual water use is 314,690 gallons, which equates to 21 gallons per SF of cultivation area. Drying and packaging occurs onsite in a 1,280-SF shed. There is an average of four (4) employees utilized throughout the year with up to eight (8) employees during peak harvest. Power is provided to the site by PG&E.
