## Humboldt Sunrise Farms, Conditional Use Permit

Record Number PLN-12285-CUP Assessor's Parcel Number: 217-411-008. Blocksburg area

A Conditional Use Permit for continued cultivation of 9,300 square feet of outdoor cannabis cultivation and 1,800 square feet of mixed light cannabis cultivation.
