Semi-Annual Humboldt County Sanctuary Ordinance Report-Probation Department

That the Board of Supervisors:

DISCUSSION:

Pursuant to Section 9121-10 of the Humboldt County Code, the Probation Officer shall provide to the Board of Supervisors a written report stating the number of detentions that were solely based on civil immigration detainers (if any) by no later than June and December of each year. The report shall address the following issues for the time period covered by the report:

(a) A description of all communication received from the federal agency charged with enforcement of the federal immigration law, including but not limited to the number of civil

immigration detainers, notification requests, and other types of communication.

(b) A description of any communications the department made to the federal agency charged

With enforcement of the federal immigration law, including but not limited to any department's responses to inquires described herein.
