SUBJECT:

Consider Support for Senate Bill 212 (SB 212)(Senator Ben Allen) to Give General Law Cities, Counties and School Districts the Ability to Adopt two Majority-Winner Voting Methods: two-Round Runoff and Ranked Choice Voting (RCV) for Local Elections (Supervisor Mike Wilson)

1. Consider sending a letter in support of SB 212 to the Chair of the Senate Elections and Constitutional Amendments Committee, State Capitol, Room #2203, Sacramento, CA 95814.

DISCUSSION:

SB 212 would authorize general law cities, general law counties and school districts to utilize two majority-winner voting methods for local elections: a two-round runoff and ranked choice voting (RCV). RCV can be used in single-seat or multi-seat elections, and would give local jurisdictions the same flexibility that charter cities or counties already have to conduct their elections.
