## That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Declare two (2) vehicles surplus;
2. Authorize the sale of vehicles to City of Ferndale Police Department; and
3. Deposit the revenue from the sale in the Motor Pool Fund.

## DISCUSSION:

The following vehicles have been replaced after being fully depreciated and instead of going into the surplus auction, the Public Works Department wishes to direct the sale of these vehicles to the City of Ferndale Police Department to replace their aging patrol vehicles.

Equipment \# 072002017 Ford Interceptor
Equipment \# 071952015 Ford Interceptor

## FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Revenue from the sale of the surplus vehicles will be deposited in the Motor Pool budget (3500-351) and used to offset the purchase of replacement vehicles. The revenue covers the salvage value of each vehicle at $\$ 2,500$ each. Total revenue of $\$ 5,000$ was included in the proposed fiscal year 2021-22 budget.
