I. CALL TO ORDER & INTRODUCTION OF ATTENDEES

IV. APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Meeting minutes from the 02/26/2026 meeting.

Raven Majors motioned to approve minutes.

Natalie Arroyo seconded.

VI. DISCUSSION/ACTION ITEMS:

- Review funding proposals:
 - First Five Humboldt
 - Mary Ann Hansen gave an overview of First 5 Humboldt's program: Triple P – Positive Parenting Program. Mary Ann highlighted the evidence behind Triple P's success in our community. The funding requested was 44,242.00, per year, for three years.
 - Two Feathers
 - Amy Mathieson gave an overview of the program, the youth who are employed and the services provided during the season. The funding requested came in two forms, an original request of 50,786.50, and a revised request of \$44,785.00, per year, for three years.
 - Teen Court

- Teen Lounge
 - The Boys and Girls Club of the Redwoods, which houses both Teen Court and Teen Lounge Programs, decided to put forth a joint proposal. Raven Majors, Julia Dunn, and Tatiana Ford gave descriptions of the programs, highlighting the success rates of both. The funding amount requested was \$216,000.00 per year, for two years.
- There was discussion about how to move forward with the requests. Coral Sanders noted that Probation has budgeted around \$318,000.00 for funding requests, and the revised requests brought forth total \$305,027.00. This leaves roughly \$13,000.00 remaining.
- There was discussion about the possibility of saving the remaining amount or distributing it to the programs.
- A proposal was brought forth, to fund Boys and Girls Club (Teen Court and Teen Lounge) and Two Feathers at the proposed levels, and to allocate the remaining to First 5, in addition to their original request.
- Natalie Arroyo moved to approve this proposal. Meara Hatten seconded. Motion carries 7-0.
- There was follow-up discussion about how to highlight the benefit of these programs to the community, and program leads unanimously decided to collaborate outside of the meeting to share information in the future.

VIII. FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS: To be determined.

It was proposed that First 5 and Two Feathers provide updates at the next meeting if they are able.
