POST-ADOPTION SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE ____-____ ADOPTING THE COASTAL OUTDOOR LIGHTING ORDINANCE BY ADDING SECTION 313-105.1 OF CHAPTER 3 OF DIVISION 1 OF TITLE III OF THE HUMBOLDT COUNTY CODE, ESTABLISHING UNIFORM REGULATIONS FOR OUTDOOR LIGHTING WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED COASTAL AREAS OF HUMBOLDT COUNTY AND AMENDING SECTIONS 313-138, 313-141, 313-147 AND 313-154 (DEFINITIONS).

On Tuesday, July 7, 2026, during its regularly scheduled Board meeting, the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors repealed Ordinance 2768 and adopted Ordinance No. _____ which adopts the Coastal Outdoor Lighting Ordinance as modified by the California Coastal Commission.

The California Coastal Commission certified the Coastal Outdoor Lighting Ordinance on February 4, 2026, with the suggested changes set forth in its Adopted Findings report. This ordinance incorporates the modifications suggested by the Coastal Commission to the Coastal Outdoor Lighting Ordinance.

The Coastal Outdoor Lighting Ordinance repeals the previously adopted Ordinance 2768 in its entirety; adds Section 313-105.1 and amends Sections 313-138, 313-141, 313-147 and 313-154 of Chapter 3 of Division 1 of Title III of the County Code, all relating to Outdoor Lighting within the Coastal Zone (Coastal Outdoor Lighting Ordinance). The Planning Department will notify the Coastal Commission of the County's acceptance of the Commission's suggested modifications and Commission Executive Director will determine whether the acceptance is consistent with the Commission's action. If so, the Executive Director will report the determination to the Commission at the next regularly scheduled public meeting, at which point the modified Ordinance will become effective.
