POST-ADOPTION SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE ____ ADOPTING AMENDMENTS TO THE COASTAL DENSITY BONUS REGULATIONS; AMENDING SECTIONS 313-111 AND 313-136 THROUGH 313-157 OF CHAPTER 3 OF DIVISION 1 OF TITLE III OF THE HUMBOLDT COUNTY CODE.

On Tuesday, August 11, 2026, during its regularly scheduled Board meeting, the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors repealed Ordinance 2777 and adopted Ordinance No. _____ which adopts the Amendments to the Coastal Density Bonus Ordinance as modified by the California Coastal Commission.

The California Coastal Commission certified the Amendments to the Coastal Density Bonus Ordinance on June 11, 2026, with the suggested changes set forth in its Adopted Suggested Modifications report. This ordinance incorporates the modifications suggested by the Coastal Commission into the Amendments to the Coastal Density Bonus Ordinance.

The Amendments to the Coastal Density Bonus Ordinance repeal the previously adopted Ordinance 2777 in its entirety; amending Sections 313-111 and 313-136 through 313-157 of Chapter 3 of Division 1 of Title III of the County Code, regarding Density Bonuses within the Coastal Zone and associated definitions (Amendments to the Coastal Density Bonus Ordinance). The Planning Department will notify the Coastal Commission of the County's acceptance of the Commission's suggested modifications and the Commission Executive Director will determine whether the acceptance is consistent with the Commission's action. If so, the Executive Director will report the determination to the Commission at the next regularly scheduled public meeting, at which point the modified Ordinance will become effective.
